3.0	POLICE REPORT	
3.1	Community Police – Officer Alison Lang attended. In the last period, there had been 5 crimes reported in the nature of housebreaking, vandalising and similar events. None of these had so far been detected. There had also been 5 instances of assault or drunk and disorderly behaviour. Information was given concerning changed procedures for minor offences, involving warnings instead of charging. This would bring the procedures in line with those used by Police in England. Members of the public were encouraged to phone in to 101 if there were any suspicions of people going round doors or similar. Police would be happy to follow up such suspicions, as they are often a source of detection.
