NEW PRIMARY SCHOOL - LENZIE

WORKS HAVE NOW COMMENCED:

Works commenced at the New Primary School - Lenzie on 29th June 2015.



The main entrance road reconfiguration works have now reached their conclusion ready for the start of the new term. Soil removal operations are substantially complete and work on the foundations has started.

PERIMETER HOARDING:

Hoarding panels have been installed to provide robust segregation between the existing school and the site. Viewing panels have been installed to allow the children to view progress of the construction and provide Lendlease with the opportunity to explain the various stages of the process to staff and pupils.

POSTER COMPETITION:

Prior to the end of the summer term, Lendlease visited Lenzie Moss & Lenzie Primary Schools to carry out a presentation advising the children of the dangers present on construction sites.

The pupils were asked at the presentation to participate in a competition to design a poster, warning of the dangers on construction sites. We have received numerous excellent entries and 8 of the posters have now been selected for display at our site entrance - 2 from P1-P3; and 2 from P4-P7 from each primary school. Each winning entry will receive a book voucher early in the new term.
