

We are delighted that you are considering entering an artwork for our Inspirational Art Exhibition for this year's Fairtrade Fortnight.

So that everyone knows in advance what they can expect and what is expected of **them**, we thought it would be helpful to set out a few rules, so here goes:

1. Individual entries should be a painting, drawing or collage on an A4 sheet of paper.
2. Group entries can go up to A1 size.
3. Individual entries should be delivered to Billington's Deli in the Queen's Buildings in Lenzie no later than Thursday 25th February. We need to have them before the exhibition on Saturday so we can put them up before people arrive.
4. Group and school entries will be uplifted by the Fair Trade group and stored until the show. Please email [lenziefairtrade@gmail.com](mailto:lenziefairtrade@gmail.com) by Wednesday 25th February to advise size(s) and when they can be uplifted.
5. All entries should have a Fair Trade theme.

**Here are some ideas for you to consider:**

- What is your favourite Fair Trade food? Can you draw it or a picture of someone eating it?
- Find a picture of farmers growing Fair Trade products (rice, coffee, tea, bananas) and try to draw or paint it yourself.
- Perhaps you could draw or paint a picture of your Mum or Dad shopping for Fair Trade food for dinner.
- Or maybe a picture of your brother or sister baking a cake with Fair Trade ingredients.
- Or possibly even a collage still life of Fair Trade foods which you enjoy.

**The only thing limiting you is your imagination!**

6. You may submit more than one entry if you wish but please stick to the Fair Trade themes.
7. There will be a certificate for every entry, whether created by an individual or a group.
8. Highly commended certificates will be awarded to the individuals and/or groups who - in the opinion of the on-site artist judge - make the best use of their artistic materials to convey the importance of Fair Trade.
